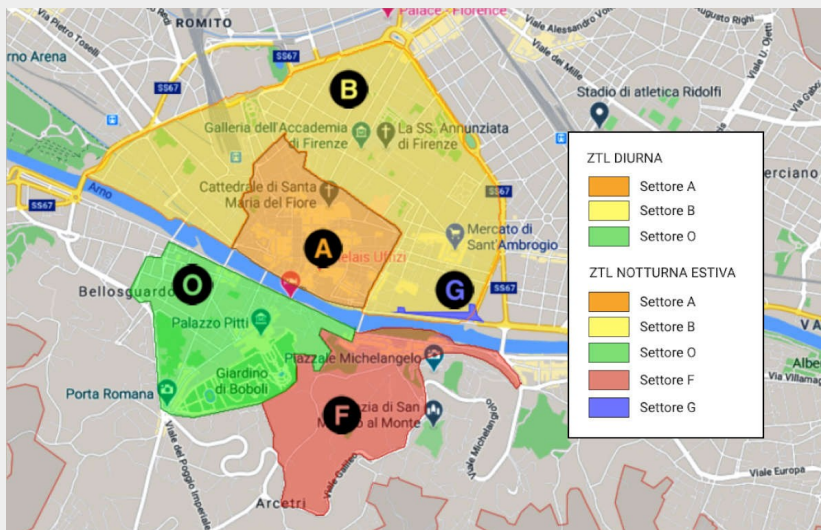
We hope your stay at our Bed & Breakfast is pleasant and unforgettable.

To help you get around the city easily, we'd like to provide you with some important information regarding the **SCUDO VERDE** (Green Shield), Florence's new Traffic Delimitation Zone, which may affect your movements around the city with private vehicles.

ATTENTION

The **SCUDO VERDE** is different from the ZTL (Limited Traffic Zone), which is a more internal area protecting the Historic Center and is delimited by other specific access points.

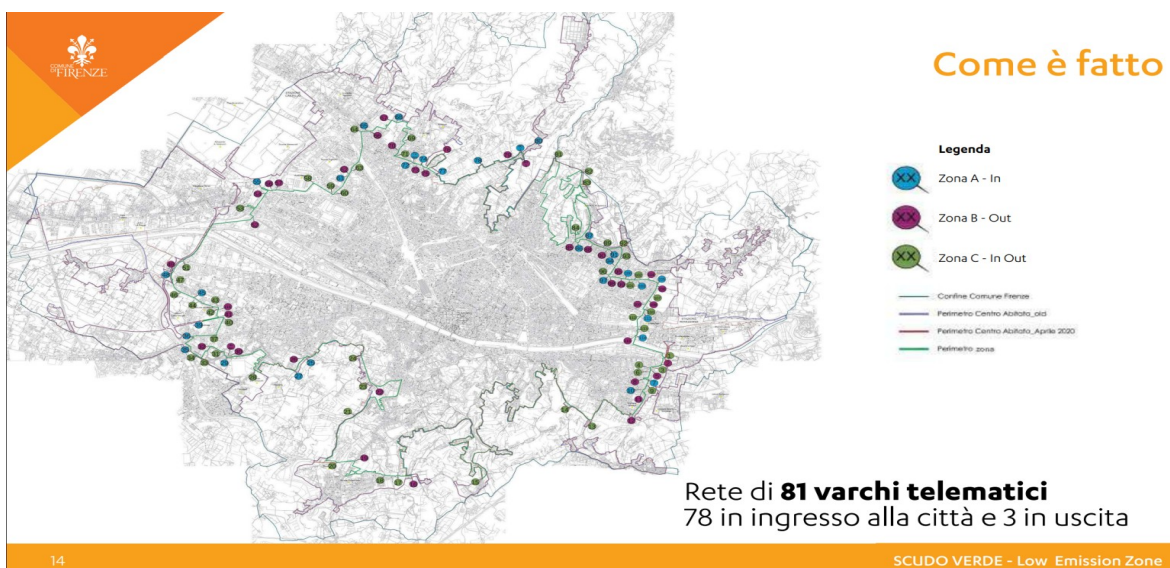

WHAT IS THE GREEN SHIELD?

The **Green Shield** is a system of cameras positioned at strategic points throughout the city that monitor vehicle access to certain areas, with the aim of improving air quality and reducing traffic congestion in the historic center of Florence.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU TOURISTS?

- **Access to the Historic Center:** Our Bed & Breakfast is located INSIDE THE GREEN SHIELD (<https://maps.app.goo.gl/LQP5FAWnzXEQKFpt6>). If you intend to reach the historic center with your car, it is essential to be aware of the Green Shield rules to avoid penalties.
- **Activation Hours:** The Green Shield will be active every day, 24 hours a day, starting from June 1st, 2025. This means that unauthorized access is always subject to control.
- **Vehicle Categories Subject to Restrictions:** The restrictions mainly concern the most polluting vehicles (Euro 0 and Euro 1). Anno	Categoria Euro interessata
2025	- Benzina Euro 0- Diesel Euro 0 e Euro 1
2026	- Diesel Euro 2
2027	- Benzina Euro 0, Euro 1, Euro 2- Diesel Euro 0, Euro 1, Euro 2, Euro 3

Alternative Transportation: Florence offers an efficient public transportation system (buses and trams) that will allow you to easily reach all the main attractions of the city. Furthermore, getting around the historic center on foot is often the best way to appreciate its beauty.
